Sorting of biowaste at source: recycling by composting

Food waste composed of about 90% water, representing nearly a third of the content of the French waste bin, is too often incinerated or buried while this organic matter could be transformed into recoverable materials (compost) and return to feed. and fertilize the soil.

As of 1rst January 2024, local authorities will have to provide sorting solutions at source of biowaste to all their residents. PTL SPHERE Group offers to support local authorities in achieving this by participating in an experiment in the Ile-de-France region, sorting and collecting food waste in voluntary collection points, using a compostable bag and a bio-bucket. These compostable plant-based bags are Origine France Garantie (OFG), meet both domestic and industrial composting needs and comply with the NF T51-800 and NF EN 13432 standards. https://www.sphere.eu/en/experiment-food-waste/
